2011-2012 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Completion Tip Sheet

Priority Date to submit the FAFSA for all continuing students is March 15, 2011.

- * Apply online at **www.fafsa.gov**.
- * If you (and your parents) have not yet completed a 2010 Federal tax return, submit the FAFSA using estimated income and update once the 2010 Federal tax return has been completed.
- * **Request a Personal Identification Number (PIN) at www.pin.ed.gov to electronically sign the FAFSA.**
- * Parents should also apply for their own PINs.
- * **Dependent students MUST provide a student signature AND a parent signature.**
- * **Read the instructions carefully and answer ALL questions that pertain to you.**
- * Questions about the FAFSA can be directed to 1-800-4-FED-AID.
- * **For Question # 101a, the School Code for USciences is 003353** for question # 101b, indicate a housing code.

Attention PharmD students

IF you will be a U1, U2, P1, P2 or P3 in 2011-2012 you must answer in the following manner:

Question #29 Enter: your grade level (“1st year/undergraduate” – “5th year/undergraduate”)

Question #30 Enter: “bachelor’s degree”

IF you will be a P4 beginning in May 2011, you must answer in the following manner:

Question #29 Enter “1st year graduate/professional”

Question #30 Enter “Graduate or professional degree”

Attention OT students

IF you will be a U1, U2, P1, or P2 in 2011-2012 you must answer in the following manner:

Question #29 Enter: your grade level (“1st year/undergraduate” - “4th year/ undergraduate”)

Question #30 Enter: “bachelor’s degree”

IF you will be a P3 in 2011-2012 or **PB MOT** in any year of study you must answer in the following manner:

Question #29 Enter: “1st year graduate/professional”

Question #30 Enter: “Graduate or professional degree”

Attention DPT students

IF you will be a U1, U2, U3, P1 or P2 in 2011-2012 you must answer in the following manner:

Question #29 Enter: your grade level (“1st year/ undergraduate” – “5th year/ undergraduate”)

Question #30 Enter: “bachelor’s degree”

IF you will be a P3 in 2011-2012 you must answer in the following manner:

Question #29 Enter: “1st year graduate/professional”

Question #30 Enter: “Graduate or professional degree”

Over for more information

For Everyone:

- * Question #28 should be answered as:
 - “No” if you are in any undergraduate program and do not have a bachelor’s degree from a previous school, OR if you are in the PharmD, DPT or OT programs and you will NOT be in your final year of study during the 2011-2012 academic year.
 - “Yes” if you will be in your final year in the PharmD, DPT or OT programs or your any year in the PBMOT program during the 2011-2012 academic year, OR if you have a bachelor’s degree from a previous school.

- * Question #47 should be answered as:
 - “No” unless you will be in your final year of a combined undergraduate/graduate program during the 2011-2012 academic year, or you are in a graduate-only program.

Once the FAFSA data has been processed, you will receive an acknowledgement in the form of a Student Aid Report (SAR). University of the Sciences will receive your SAR information electronically. Your Expected Family Contribution (EFC) will be noted on the SAR and will be used to determine your eligibility for all possible types of aid programs.

If you have been selected for Verification or need to provide additional documentation, this also should be noted on the SAR.

Pennsylvania residents please note: You will not be considered for a Pennsylvania State Grant (PHEAA Grant) unless your processed FAFSA information is received by PHEAA before May 1, 2011. According to the U.S. Department of Education, electronically completed FAFSAs take approximately 5 – 7 days to process and FAFSAs completed on paper and sent through the mail take 4 – 6 weeks to process.
