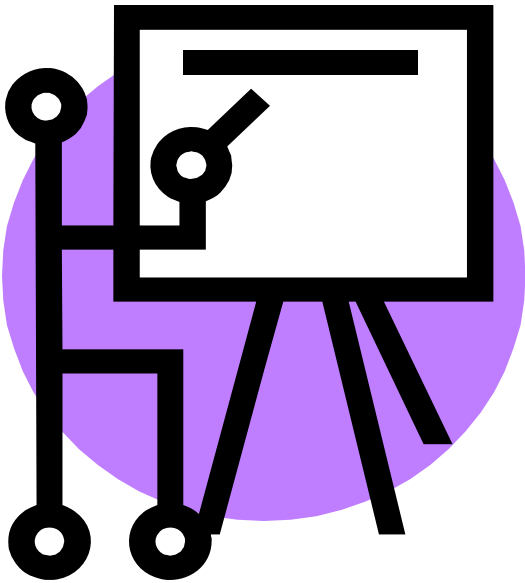


INTRODUCTION TO SPONSORED PROJECTS

This workshop will discuss all aspects of grant and contract processes. It details USciences policies and procedures and discusses PI responsibilities.

This session is especially useful for anyone new to USciences and/or writing grants and contracts for the first time.

Topics will include:

Finding Funding – demonstrates the Community of Science funding opportunities database, grants.gov and other programs used to locate external funding. Participants will be able to use the system to search for contract and grant funds.

Preparing a Budget - explain what goes into a private vs. federal budget. Participants will gain knowledge of what items to include in budgets and what items are restricted.

GrantsERA - a comprehensive grants management electronic system. It is a web-based system that simplifies proposal development, routing and review, pre- and post-award tracking, reporting, and award notification.

Non Grants.gov Proposals - Anyone considering submitting a non grants.gov proposal? Participants will understand the difference in application process between grants.gov and non grants.gov proposal submissions.
