SINGULAR OR PLURAL

some

All phrases like **one of the ...**, **some of the ...**, or **none of the ...**, require plural nouns to complete them.

A present tense verb with the added ending *-s* or *-es* must have a singular noun as its subject. If the present tense verb does not have an added *-s* or *-es* ending, the noun subject must be plural.
